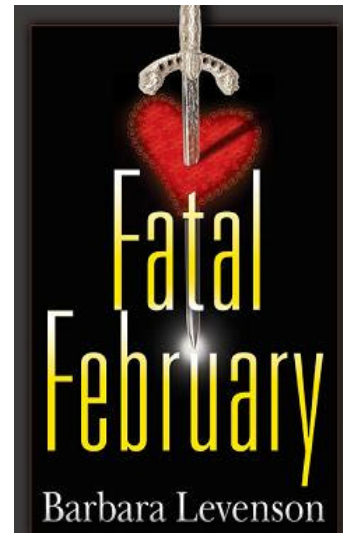

Mary becomes a detective as she searches for witnesses to defend her client. She uncovers that Mr. Yarmouth has a mistress whom fast becomes her #1 suspect as the true murderer. As Mary delves into the lives of the Yarmouths she finds her own life turned upside down, she is engaged to a man she doesn't really know much less Love, but meets Mr. Right at a carwash as he crashes into her.
